• Structured debate with written Agreement between House Leaders

- Speaker can make rulings on relevance
- Avoid filibustering and going on for 2-3 weeks
- Resolution
 - Wording must be clear, concise and structured to avoid irrelevant debate and filibustering
- 5-day Special Session
 - Most likely late August, possibly early September
 - Monday to Friday, 10:00am 5:00pm
