

Kennedy Responds to Court Challenge

The province's Natural Resources Minister is responding to the latest court challenge on Muskrat Falls. A Quebec Innu group is challenging the project in federal court based on environmental, hunting and ownership concerns. In the House yesterday, Jerome Kennedy said the latest court challenge falls in line with others that have cropped up recently. Kennedy said government will abide by whatever the courts decide.

Kennedy says bringing a legal action to court doesn't make it valid. He says at this point, there is nothing before the court that precludes the Dunderdale government from continuing to take the steps that are being taken to develop Muskrat Falls.
