Sent you a pin last evening which doesn't seem to have gone through. I made one pass through and don't really have any substantive issues with it. A few observations:

- 1. To me a doc which defends a project of this scale might be expected to be much more comprehensive and maybe the pub will have similar expectations. Based on the questions from MHI I think we can expect them to be very through and I would be concerned that this will match that. To me this read a bit like an exec summary given the scale of the project. That said all the bases were covered through at a higher level than I would have expected.
- 2. At times, particularly in the demand forecast section there were fairly significant statements and assumptions made without any obvious source material cited. When there were citations the doc was referred to but not the page. I think this could be sharpened up.
- 3. Not sure if we need to analyse the Nuke issue if it is precluded by law anyway.
- 4. Further to number 2, I wasn't particularly convinced by the demand section mostly due to the lack of support in the citation. I think Finance should review as a lot of it relies on their data.

Other than that, a lot of the report was technical and I am not really in a position to question a lot of that. It was fairly clear and effective, subject to the caveats noted earlier.
