Ms. Rebello,

I never received the document to which you refer.

You should note that my client rejected your government's approach to permitting for this project from the outset: it promised and produced your practice of emailing complex documents in English to individuals whose first language is Innu and second language is French, demanding comments in weeks but without offering any capacity or funding.

In face of your persistence in carrying out this approach, my client's failure to respond should not ever be taken as constituting any position other than its disinclination to devote limited resources to participating in the charade that the Government of Newfoundland has organized instead of meaningful consultation and accommodation.

I would appreciate receiving a copy of future correspondence to the Conseil des Innus de Ekuanitshit but I would insist on your noting that should my office fail to respond, the Government of Newfoundland is expressly instructed to draw no conclusion from our silence, except that your so-called consultation procedure remains as inadequate today as when it was proposed.
