Good afternoon Dawn

We are trying to establish where on the timeline (the deadline being December 31, 2013) Nalcor is with its work to ensure it meets the conditions precedent of the Federal Loan Guarantee.

As you are aware, one of the FLG Conditions Precedent stipulates the following:

- B. The following conditions precedent (the "FLG Conditions Precedent") must be satisfied by the applicable Borrower in form and substance acceptable to the Guarantor prior to the execution and delivery of the FLG for each Project of such Borrower:
- (ix) Review of technical aspects of the Projects, including engineering, water resource and any other required due diligence by the Independent Engineer (as defined herein), and preparation and finalization (as confirmed by the Guarantor and Lenders, acting reasonably) of a technical due diligence report (the "IE DD Report") confirming that the Project execution plans are commercially reasonable, and consistent with Good Utility Practice; and

The response we received from the Department of Natural Resources from an ATTIP we filed, where we asked for all reports presented to the provincial government by the Independent Engineer, MWH Global, as required by the Federal Loan Guarantee Term Sheet, was they "had no responsive records."

I assume that meant they had yet to receive a report from the Independent Engineer. Is that a correct assumption?

We have a few other questions:

Does Nalcor now have that report in its possession?

Can we have a copy of that report?

If Nalcor does not have a copy, when does Nalcor expect that work to be done, bearing in mind we are in the almost in the last quarter of 2013?

Will we be able to have a copy of that report when it is completed?
