I held a lengthy call with Jim Meaney at Nalcor. I clearly and with no lack of certainty delivered the messages from yesterday's call. They believe that they can tackle and answer the various issues and questions on a timely basis with a view to as complete as possible a mid-November report. I stress that that is my plan and the ting I have been controlling to since we determined the timing to closing would give us time to assess and deal with outstandings and issues with a report on that timing (but not after we must have a good report for then).
