- Presentation of Contractor mobilization readiness checklist.

Company reiterates that the timing for Contractor's issuance of these documents is now critical and Contractor is therefore requested to submit an action plan, no later than Tuesday, 25 August 2015, showing Contractor's best and realistic schedule for these documents submittal.

- Detailed Revised Construction Plan in P6 version to compare against the latest schedule issued in the last Monthly Progress Report. This should include commentary regarding schedule set up and assumptions, acceleration strategies and critical path analysis;
- Update on Site organization; and
- Selection of subcontractors Electrical.
