Confirmation of Performance Default

Dear Mr. Mavromatis:

Company provided Contractor with a Notice of Default on March 4, 2016. The particulars of the default were set out in that letter. Company required Contractor to submit the following to commence to rectify the default: (1) a detailed resource loaded recovery plan to satisfy the river diversion date of June 15, 2016, and (2) individual letters from contractors/subcontractors confirming their commitment to that recovery plan. Contractor has failed to deliver the required recovery plan and confirmation letters from its subcontractors.

Therefore, Company confirms that Contractor is in default. Company will call upon the letters of credit provided by Contractor as security for performance of the Work if Contractor's default continues without sufficiency of sustained and effective effort by Contractor to rectify the default and / or Company incurs damages in terms of time and cost. Company's recourse against the letters of credit may be made by Company at any time without further notice to Contractor.
