Purpose

Decision for River Closure:

- Preparatory Works supporting river closure was scheduled to commence 2-May
- 1st step approval on 02-May (el 18.5 m Cofferdam 2 & 3 crest levels)
- 2nd step approval on 20-May (el. 16.5 m Area J Cofferdam 2 & 3 crest level)
- 3rd step to be approved prior to 2-June (ie. 1 month later than scheduled).

Problem Definition:

- Andritz's progress on P1A work required for commencement of river closure has improved. Completion of P1A work in Jul-2016 achievable.
- LCP decision required to allow Barnard to continue preparatory work supporting
 2016 river closure schedule including timely completion of cofferdam to create ice cover and install log boom.




2 Astaldi has spillway discharge liner work in progress and working with Completions team. Punchlist items for all other P1A work activities required to support river closure are being cleared.

Several key Contractor performance issues being mitigated by LCP:

Current Issues:

- Andritz management of subcontractors
- Andrtiz plan for remaining P1A
- Andritz commercial position with regards to acceleration costs to be addressed separately



3 Issue: Andritz Management

- Andritz is showing success in managing subcontractors to achieve reasonable productivity levels
- Productivity continues to improve
- LCP team continues to work very closely with Andritz to assist daily coordination
- Organizational improvements to Andritz site team implemented.



3 Issue: Plan for remaining P1A scope

- Andritz plans have improved. Continuous refinement to plans continue. Civil subcontractor (CRT) now out of upstream area, simplifying mechanical planning and coordination for remaining heavy mechanical installation work.
- LCP working with Andritz to mitigate delays. Tower Crane collision with South Stair Tower potential 5-7 day delay to critical path. Rescheduling in process. Working on alternate available workfronts.
- LCP continues to provide significant input to Andritz to assist development of completions and commissioning deliverables.

3 Issue: Andritz Commercial Position

- Andritz is aware that they are on critical path for diversion.
- Commercial discussions set aside to allow everyone to focus on completing tasks at hand.



Recommended Action - permit Barnard to continue removal work as per phased approach to prepare for 2016 River Closure

In summary – recommended LCP Action includes:

- Approve lowering Cofferdam 2 to el. 6m
- Approve removing Cofferdam 3 to top of rock plug (el. 11m)
- Approve RCC cofferdam lowering to el. 11.5 m



- 5 Risks associated with continued cofferdam removals need to be considered.
 - Barnard will soon have completed all approved low risk preparatory works.
 - Continued removal <u>without</u> diverting in 2016 results in:
 - Need to rebuild cofferdams RCC, 2 & 3 after removal.
 - Removal of cofferdams twice.
 - Total cost \$55M includes penalty for Barnard.
 - Decision now to not divert in 2016 results in:
 - \$25M penalty for Barnard.

Based on Astaldi and Andritz's progress on Spillway Readiness and LCP Team Readiness recommendation is to proceed with removals in preparation for River Diversion in 2016.
