I have received and thank you for your letter of 3 July 2015.

Your willingness to consider Astaldi's request for the return and suspension of the advance payment recovery is a positive development. I await your formal response on that issue.

It is my understanding that our project teams met in Goose Bay to define and agree to the detailed re-baseline schedule and the workforce requirements on 9 July 2015 and our external counsel had a productive off-the-record initial meeting on the same date, in Halifax, which I consider to be another positive development.

I have today instructed our external counsel to write to your external counsel to recommend details of a collaborative approach to the resolution of our various issues. I would encourage and welcome your support so that said initiative may start soon.

Meanwhile it is my understanding that our project teams are working jointly to define the detailed re-baseline schedule and the workforce requirements for the successful achievement of the Project.
