Where the assistant deputy minister or an officer is of the opinion that work is being carried out in a way that the conditions at the workplace pose an immediate risk to the health and safety of workers engaged in the workplace or other persons at or near the workplace, the assistant deputy minister or officer shall, in writing, order the person at the workplace responsible for the work being carried out to immediately stop all or a portion of the work and to vacate all or a portion of the workplace; and

Part III - General Duties

14 1- General duties of employers

An employer shall ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, that all buildings, structures, whether permanent or temporary, excavation, machinery, workstations, places of employment and equipment are capable of withstanding the stresses likely to be imposed upon them and of safely performing the functions for which

they are used or intended.

26 - 1e -Powers of investigation

For the purpose of ensuring compliance with the Act or regulations and an order made under either of them, the assistant deputy minister, or an officer may make examinations and conduct investigations that he or she consider necessary in order to determine the cause and particulars of an accident or illness occurring to worker or self-employed person that appears to the investigator as having been caused as a result of an activity at the workplace.

The following information shall be provided.

- -engineering drawings for the falsework/formwork
- -assembly instructions for the falsework/formwork
- -inspections/signoffs for the falsework/formwork
- -concrete placing procedures
- -concrete batch tickets and information on placement rate
- -concrete testing records including concrete density
- -concrete mix design and any changes made to it during the pour
