Just a couple of observations made over the last two days:

a.) In conversation with Guido V. yesterday on the need for Astaldi to take ownership of inbound freight and the notion that Astaldi needs to have resources in place to manage such was met with the statement that this "may require a change order as it was not previously expected". This conversation came in light of the fact that Kevin Miller and our safety department had to clearly communicated the guidlines to all contractors including Astaldi that they have to ensure that all people allowed on site need to be managed safely. This distribution came after an incident that Astaldi experienced where a truck driver was noted on top of a load of structural steel well in excess of 6 feet. There have been numerous safety incidents with Astaldi subs and suppliers. This statement, specific to the freight incident, does not reflect the intention of Astaldi as defined in their Project Execution Plan Section D.2 which clearly states that Astaldi will have a local logistics team to manage.

b.) During a 4pm close-out meeting with Astaldi Vittorio R. stated that Astaldi did not expect to have to place forms against an uneven surfaces and that this will require a change order to cover the additional resources required to construct.

I believe that the theme discovered in the monthly report will resurface again and again. I think it is important for our team to assist but be very careful as not to direct. There is an obvious "change order"and/or substantiate "claim" theme developing amongst their leadership.

I believe we need to professionally challenge some of the topics of the monthly report even though it is retracted, your thoughts? We could list them as topics to be discussed without referencing the report???
