Many issues which may have contributed to the failure but does not delineate any one specifically. Could have been one factor or a combination of many.

Focus appears to be primarily on formwork support towers but also identified problems with other elements of the form work as well. Observations rely in part from other draft tubes given that significant portions of the DT2 formwork were buried in hardened concrete.

Contributing factors include:

Poor design specifications,

Poor fabrication of before install,

Poor installation,

Poor material handling and effects of significant weathering on the formwork

I my view, the authors appear critical of the entire situation right from engineering design to signoff of installed formwork.

Exact words in the conclusion read:

"The findings of this report suggest that one of the following occurred:

The shoring system was not designed properly

ii Wood integrity of the formwork was compromised

iii The shoring system was not installed correctly

iv the shoring system fabrication system was inadequate

V A combination of the aforementioned factors

There are many potential issues discussed within the report which may have influences the load-carry capibility of the shoring system:

- The shoring tower's capabpility was under-designed
- The tower leg lumber splices could have been inadequate
- The form work installation may have been deficient.
- The integrety of the woood material could have been comprimised."
