April 30, 2019 – Nalcor and Trades NL were recently honoured with a prestigious Health and Safety Distinction Award from Canada's Building Trades Unions (CBTU).

In March 2019, the Muskrat Falls Project achieved two years without a lost-time incident. This month, we reached more than 15 million hours worked without a lost-time incident.

The CBTU handed out four Distinction Awards in celebration of labour leaders, construction owners, employers and government who have made significant contributions to their fields and supported nation building through creating sustainable development approaches that transform the lives of Canadians.
