Re: Your request for access to information under Part II of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 2015 (File #: PB/972/2018)

On December 24, 2018, Nalcor Energy received your request for access to the following records:

1/ Nalcor has stated no cost Churchill Falls recall was assumed for 50 years(PB-32-2018) for 76 MW to fill the LIL to 900 MW capacity (MF 824+ 76 MW recall) Provide the public reports which show that Nalcor advised the public that 76 MW of no cost recall was used for Muskrat costing purposes.

There is no public report which is responsive to the request. However, we wish to clarify the response given to PB/32/2018. Recall energy use for the Island is for meeting Island peak demand only and is thus used only for the duration of the peak periods. Except for the periods of peak demand on the Island, the LIL is not expected to operate at its 900 MW capacity to meet domestic requirements.

It is the goal to publish this letter following a 72 hour period after it is sent electronically to you or five business days in the case where the letter has been mailed to you.

Please be advised that you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review the processing of your access request, as set out in section 42 of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act). A request to the Commissioner must be made in writing within 15 business days of the date of this letter or within a longer period that may be allowed by the Commissioner. Your appeal should identify your concerns with the request and why you are submitting the appeal.
