Dear Mr. Martin,

In preparation for the upcoming Special Debate on Muskrat Falls we are seeking to clarify some points which have been raised by Government.

At this time we are requesting the following items and any pertinent information that would apply in relation to these items:

1. Copy of the Decision Gate Three (DG3) numbers.
2. Copy of the most recent load demand forecasts for the province.
3. Contract agreement and Terms of Reference for the current contract with Manitoba Hydro International (MHI) as well as any and all draft versions of the MHI report/study submitted to Nalcor.
4. Copies of reports/studies completed by ZIFF Energy, and/or any other consultant, on natural gas as well as copies of the contract agreement(s) and Terms of Reference for the report(s)/study(ies).
5. Copies of reports/studies completed on wind energy, the name of the consultant(s), as well as contract agreement(s) and Terms of Reference for these report(s)/study(ies).
6. Copies of reports/studies and analysis related to alternate hydro project configurations (i.e. Gull Island project analysis and related materials, reports/studies, financial statements, market reports).
7. Copy of the latest budget and timelines for the Muskrat Falls Project as well as the equity requirement for the province and Nalcor.
8. Copy of the hydrological report/study that was provided to Emera Energy regarding minimum average energy production of Muskrat Falls Power, as per section 5.2 (d) of the Maritime Link – Joint Development Agreement.
9. Copies of meeting minutes with offshore companies related to the supply of natural gas.

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12. Copies of all meeting minutes related to the purchase of power from Hydro Quebec.
13. Copies of any and all Water Rights Agreements with Hydro Quebec.
14. Copies of any and all Water Rights Agreements with Churchill Falls (Labrador) Corporation (CF(L)Co).
15. Details of the law firm(s) that worked for Nalcor as well as Emera Energy to develop the thirteen (13) legal agreements for the Muskrat Falls Project, including their billings and scope of work.
16. Breakdown of monies spent, by month, on the Muskrat Falls Project since the announcement of the project in November 2010.
17. Details about the aboriginal artifacts that have been uncovered at the site of the Muskrat Falls Project since construction started.
18. List of recommendations from the Joint Review Panel that have not yet been implemented.
19. A decision as to whether or not Nalcor will build the Maritime Link if Emera Energy does not decide to opt in by 2014.
