- In all three regions females make up the largest number of lone parent families 87% in the town of Stephenville; 85% in the town of Cape St. George; and 82% in the city of St. John’s
- **Stephenville (Town)** - Females make up 61% of all After Tax Income earners under \$10,000; 60% in the After Tax Income \$10,000 - \$19,000; and 62% in the After Tax Income from \$20,000 - \$20,999; but very relevant to note that females made up only 38% in the higher income bracket \$30,000 +.
- **Cape St. George (Town)** - Females make up 63% of all After Tax Income earners under \$10,000; 58% in the After Tax Income \$10,000 - \$19,000; and 54% in the After Tax Income from \$20,000 - \$20,999; but very relevant to note that females made up only 26% in the higher income bracket \$30,000 +.
- **St. John’s (City)** - Females make up 56% of all After Tax Income earners under \$10,000; 59% in the After Tax Income \$10,000 - \$19,000; and 59% in the After Tax Income from \$20,000 - \$20,999; but very relevant to note that females made up only 45% in the higher income bracket \$30,000 +.
- Data indicates that females primarily have lower incomes and male primarily have higher incomes
